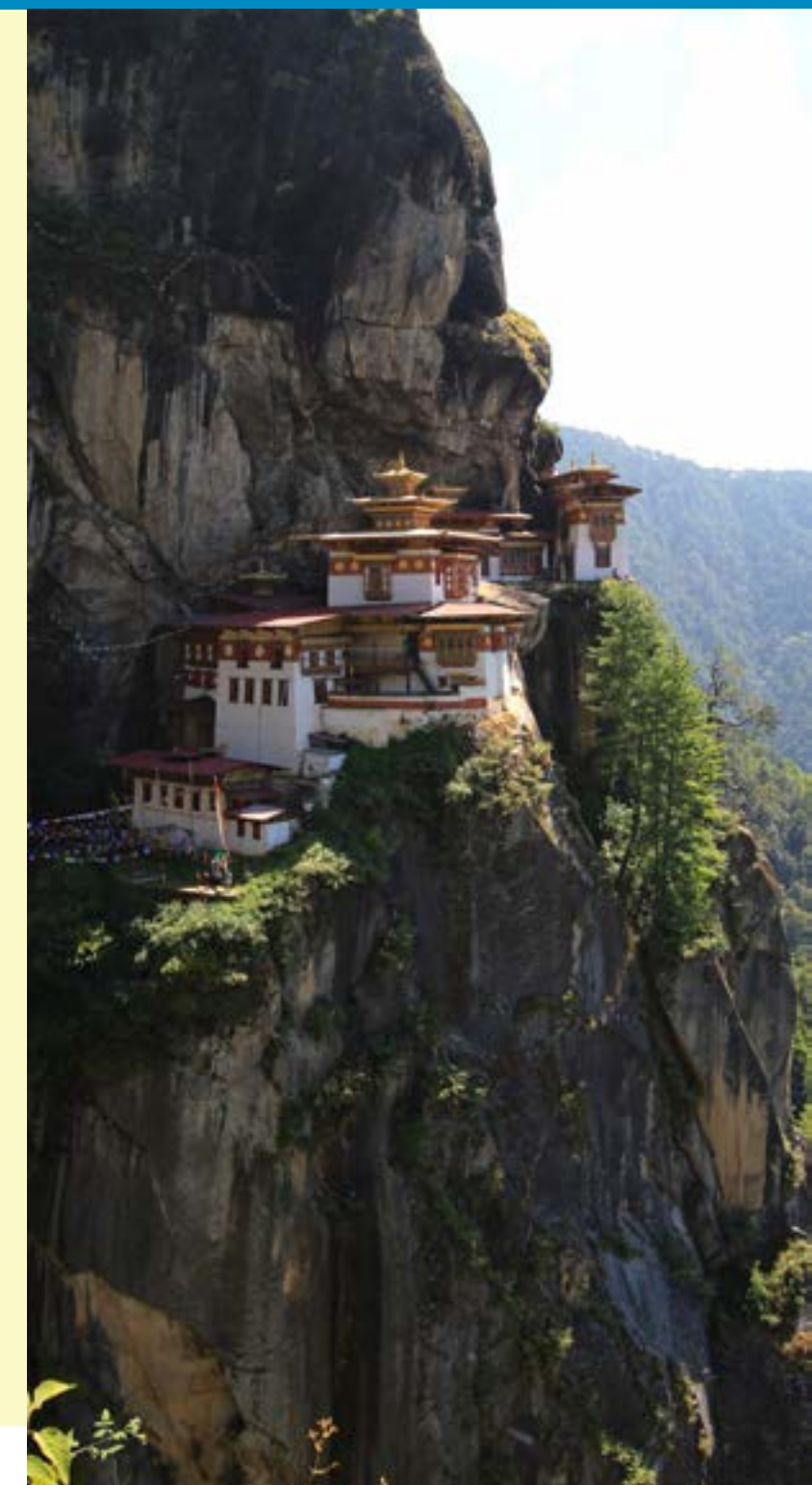

## International Air Route Map

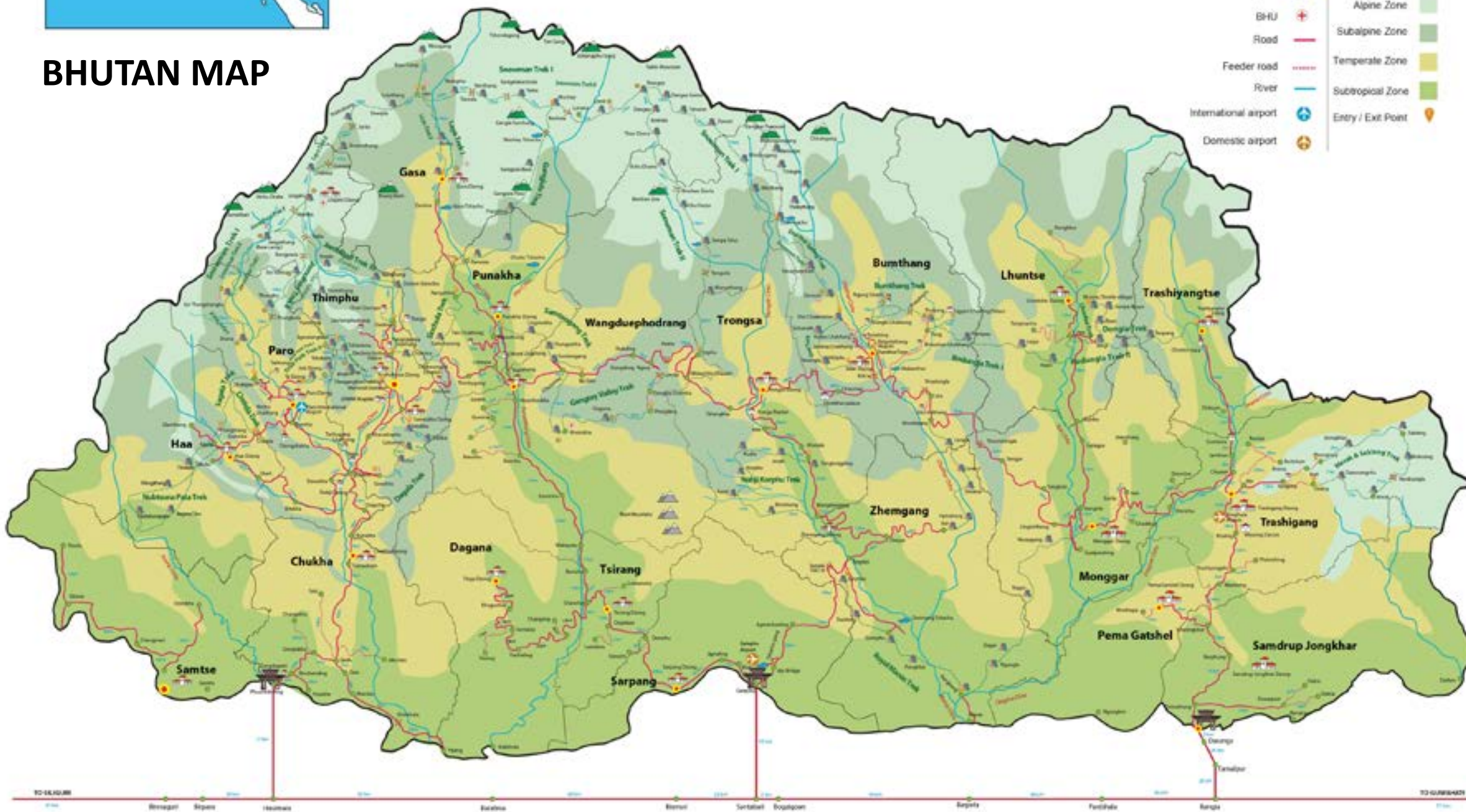

## TOUR PRICE

Payments must be made in US dollars prior to arrival in Bhutan. The minimum daily package for tourists travelling in a group of three persons or more is as follows:

- US\$ 200 per person per night for the months of January, February, June, July, August and December.
- US\$ 250 per person per night for the months of March, April, May, September, October and November.

## LOOK WHAT YOU GET FOR ONLY US \$200 OR US \$250 PER DAY.

- Meet and greet at Paro, currently Bhutan's only international airport
- A free gift of a cap or scarf upon arrival
- Free airport transfers
- A free Bhutan government Visa
- A free detailed topographical map of Bhutan
- All accommodation and portorage in three star hotels throughout Bhutan (4 & 5 star hotels may be available at an additional cost)
- All meals daily (breakfast, lunch and dinner)
- Refreshments daily (bottled mountain spring water and juice)
- A licensed bilingual or multilingual guide to accompany you on all treks and tours
- All travel by private car, 4wd or bus as appropriate
- Free locally brewed wine, beer or soft drinks at your hotels
- All camping equipment (other than personal clothing) on all walking and trekking tours
- All internal taxes and charges
- A sustainable development fee of US\$ 65 per person per day. This Royalty goes towards free education, free healthcare and poverty alleviation, along with the building of infrastructure.
